The Recovery Support Services certificate is offered by the Psychology Department. This certificate prepares students to provide recovery support to individuals struggling with substance abuse and/or mental health issues in order to help them maintain their recovery while living in the community. Through coursework, practicum and field training, students learn to assist clients in rebuilding their lives. Students receive instruction that will prepare them to take professional certification exams and provide them with competitive job skills in a career that is projected to grow significantly in the future.
